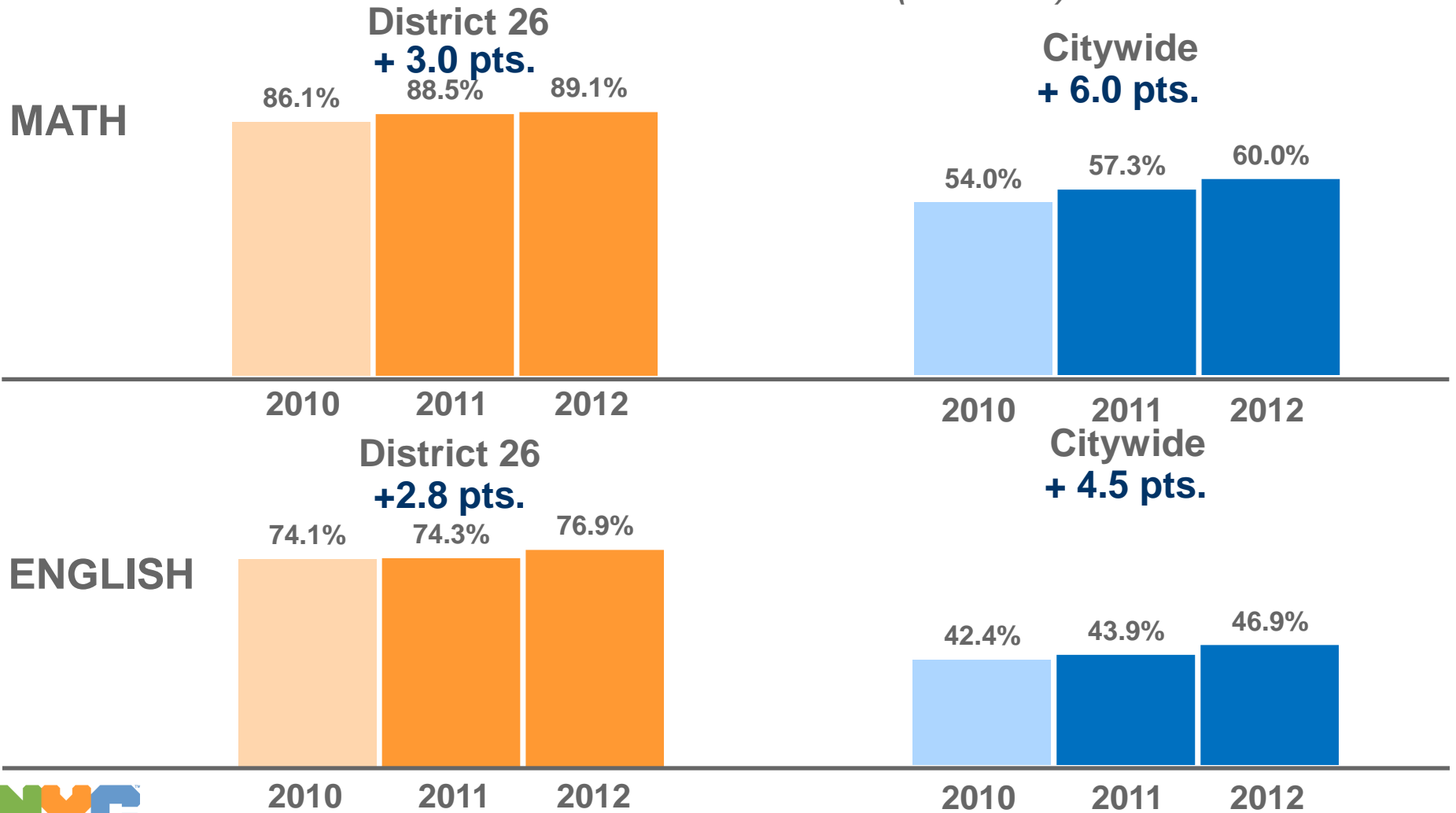

2010 - 2012 Percent of Students Meeting/Exceeding New York State Standards on New York State Grades 3-8 Tests (Levels 3+4)

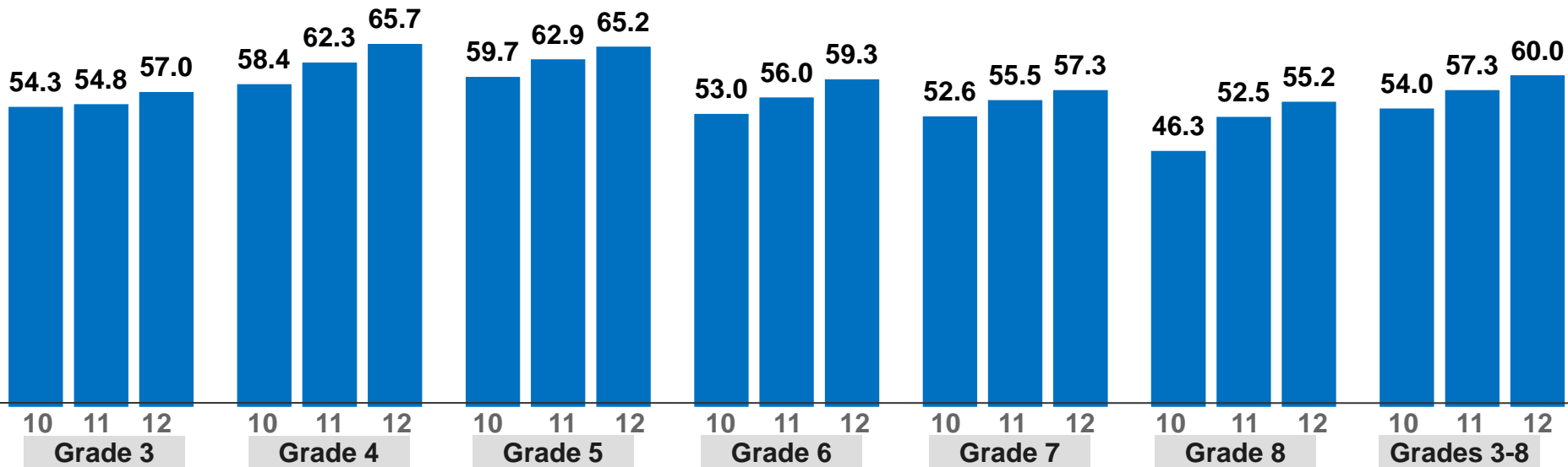

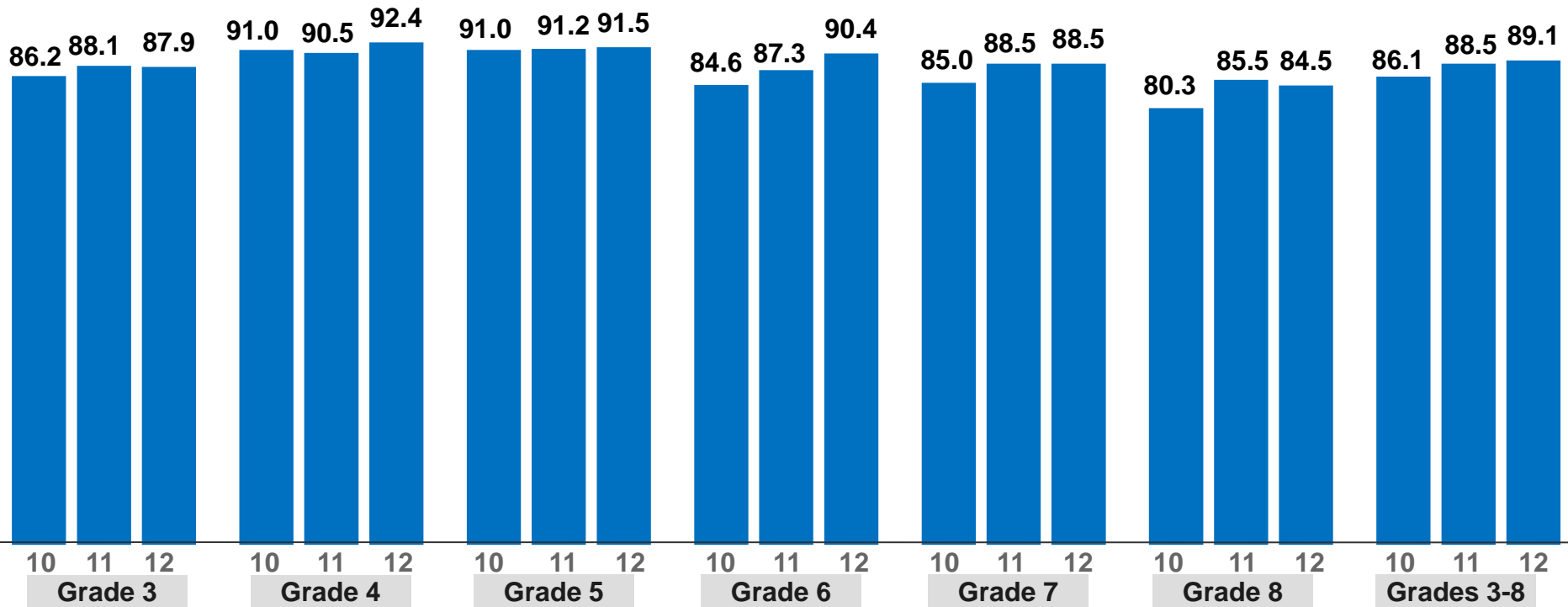

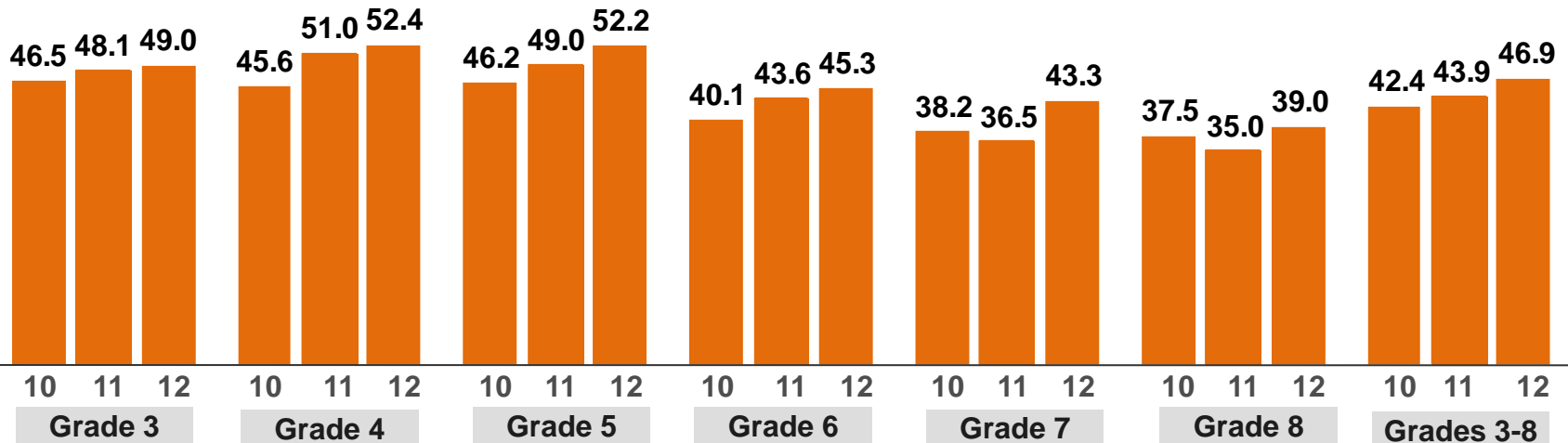

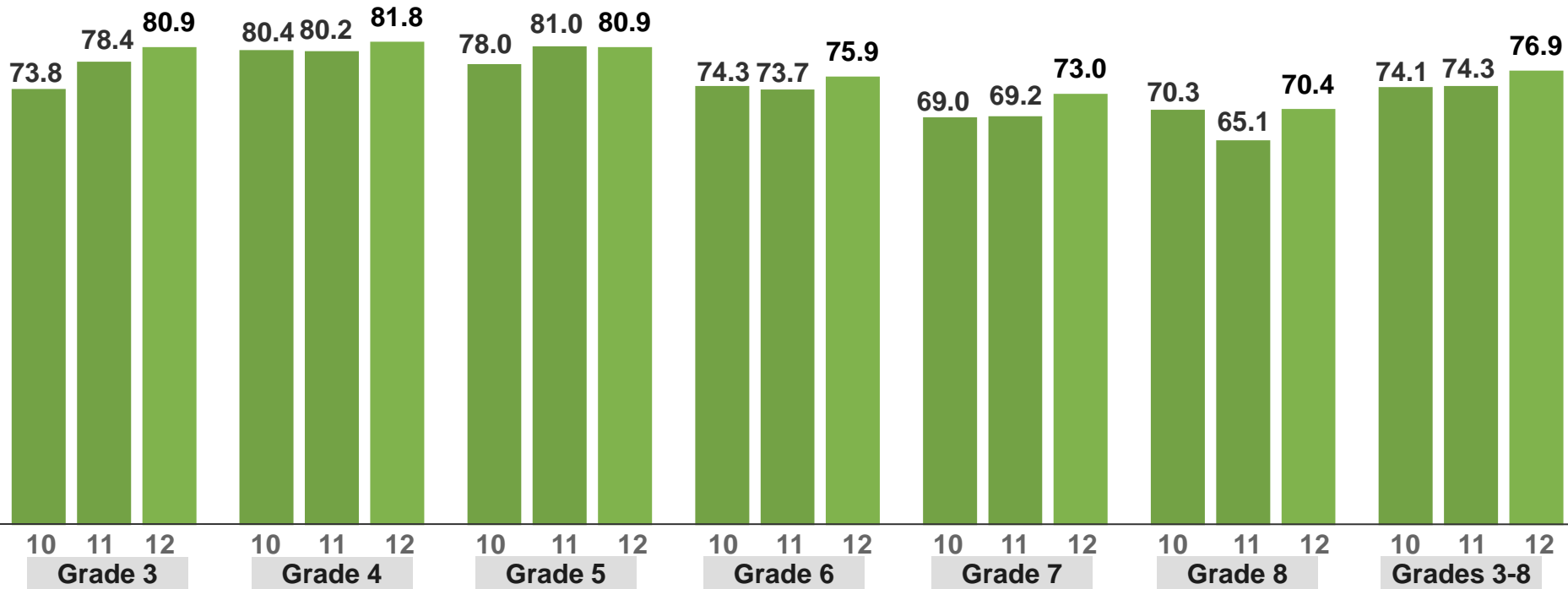

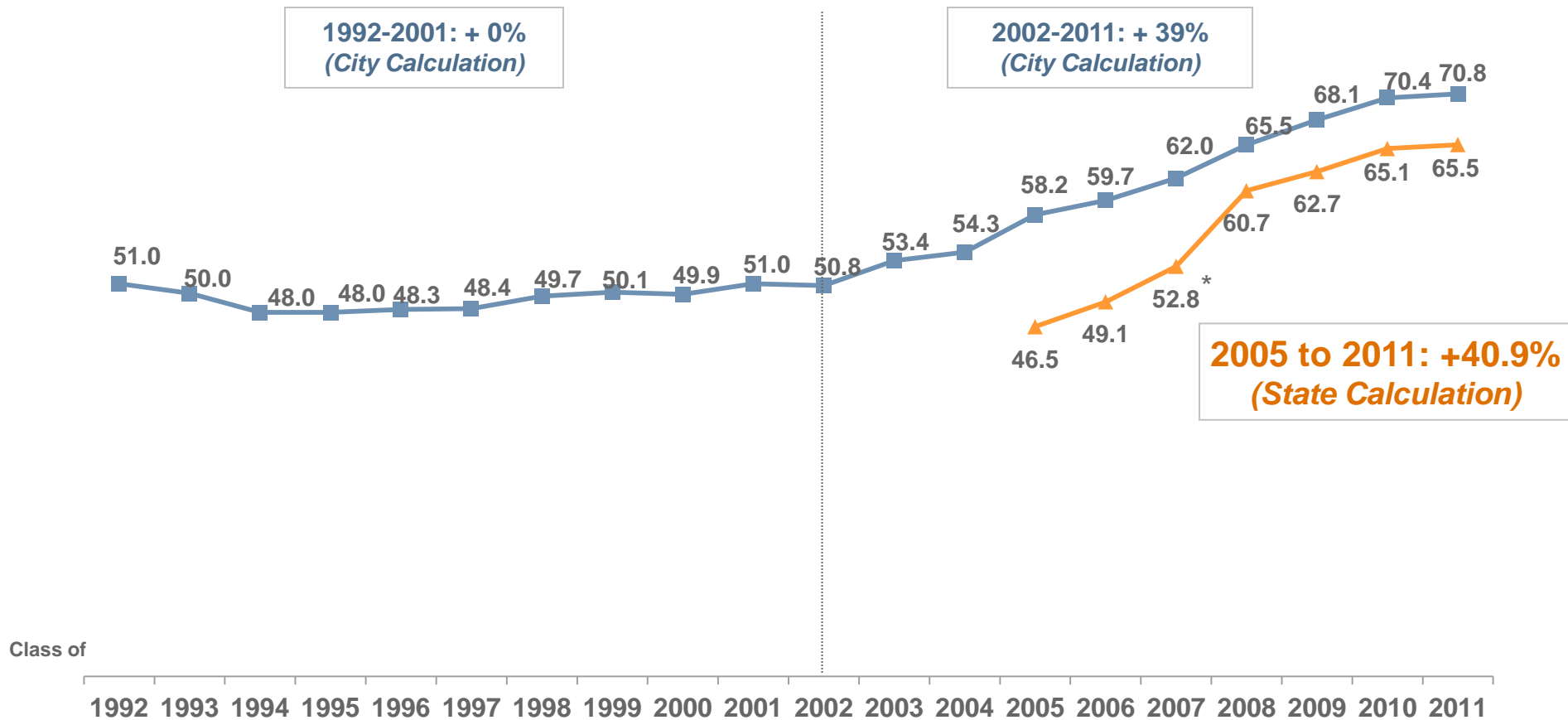

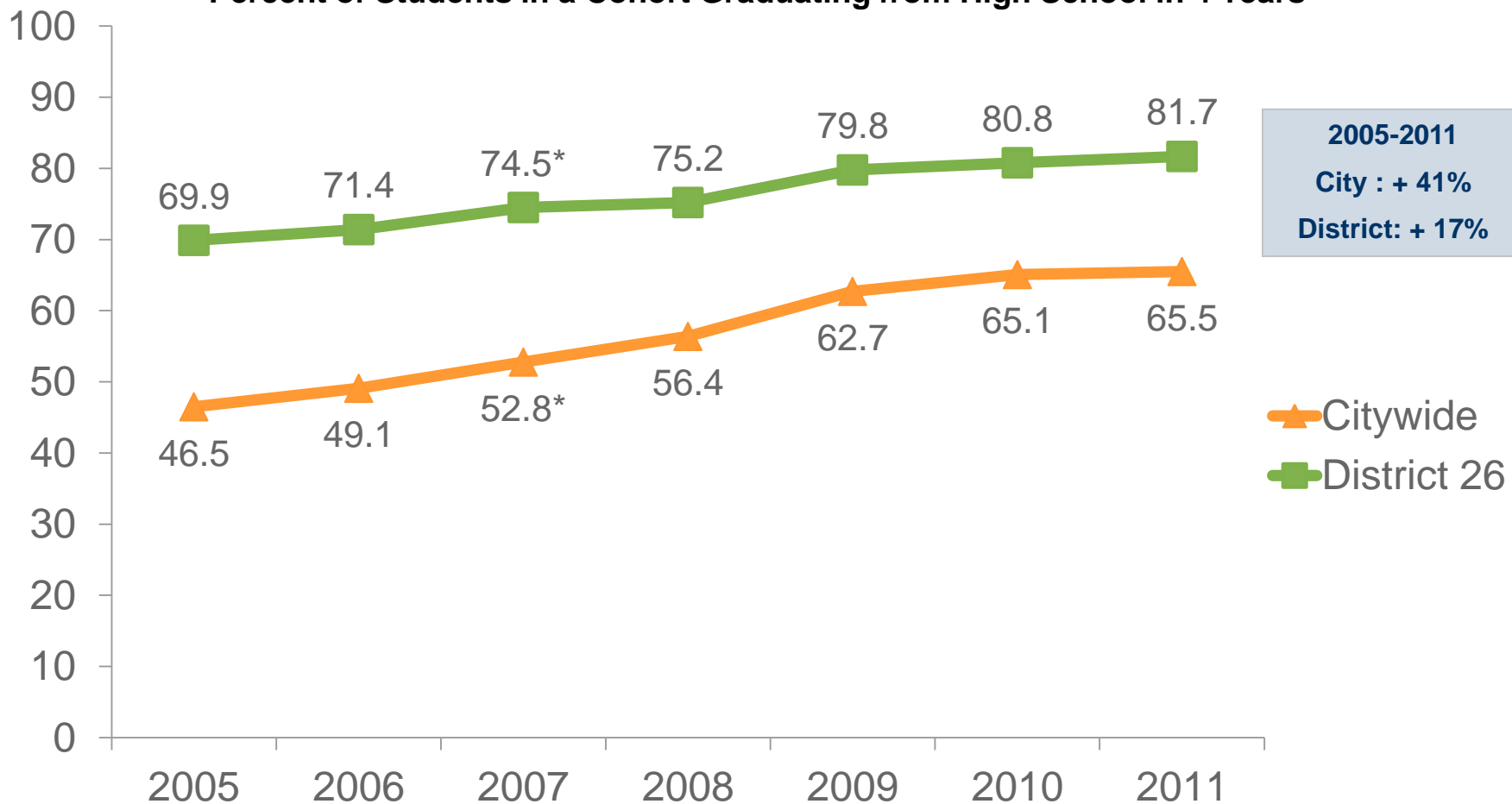

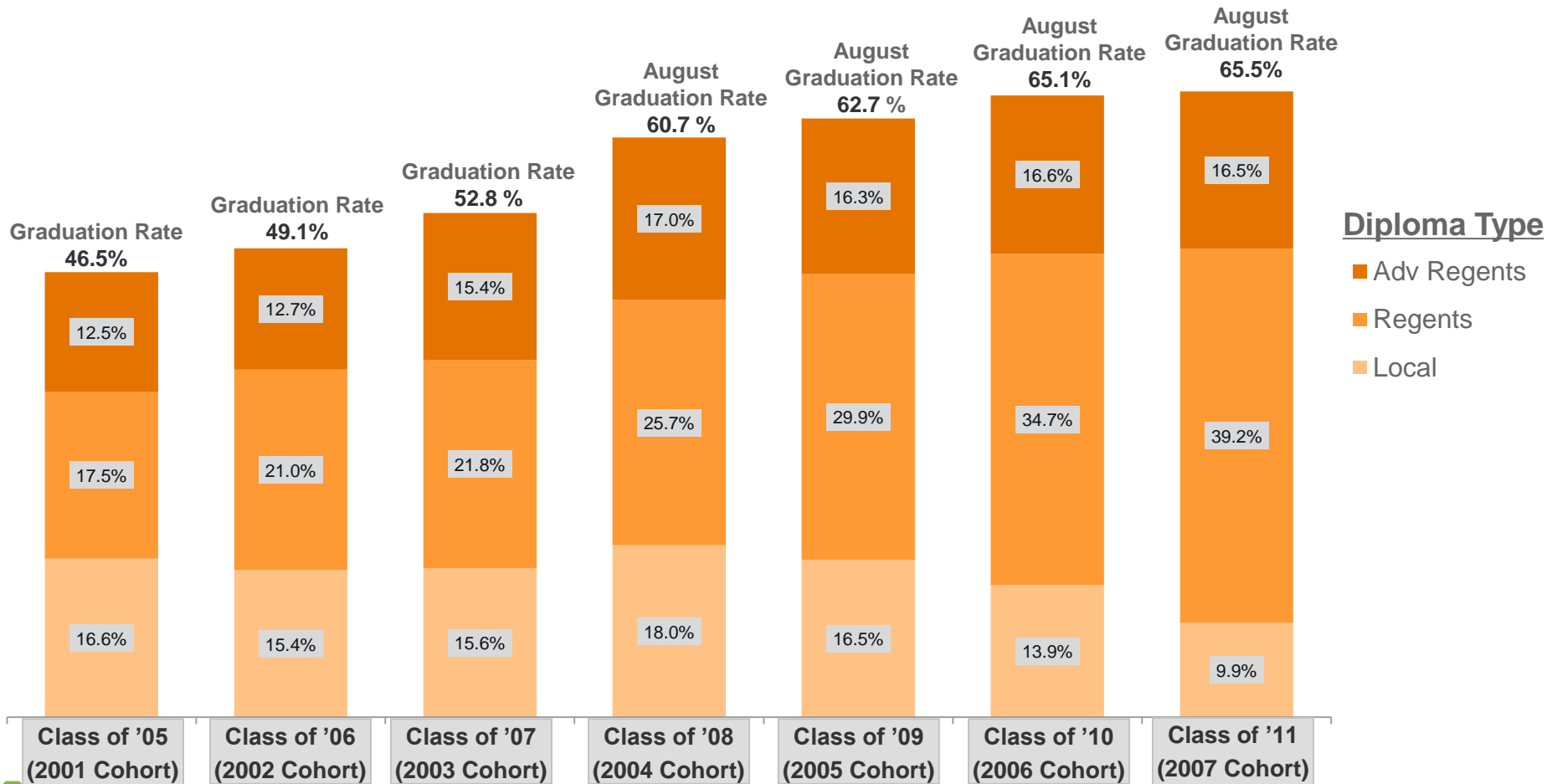
EIGHTY-TWO PERCENT OF **DISTRICT 26** STUDENTS GRADUATE IN FOUR YEARS

Percent of Students in a Cohort Graduating from High School in 4 Years



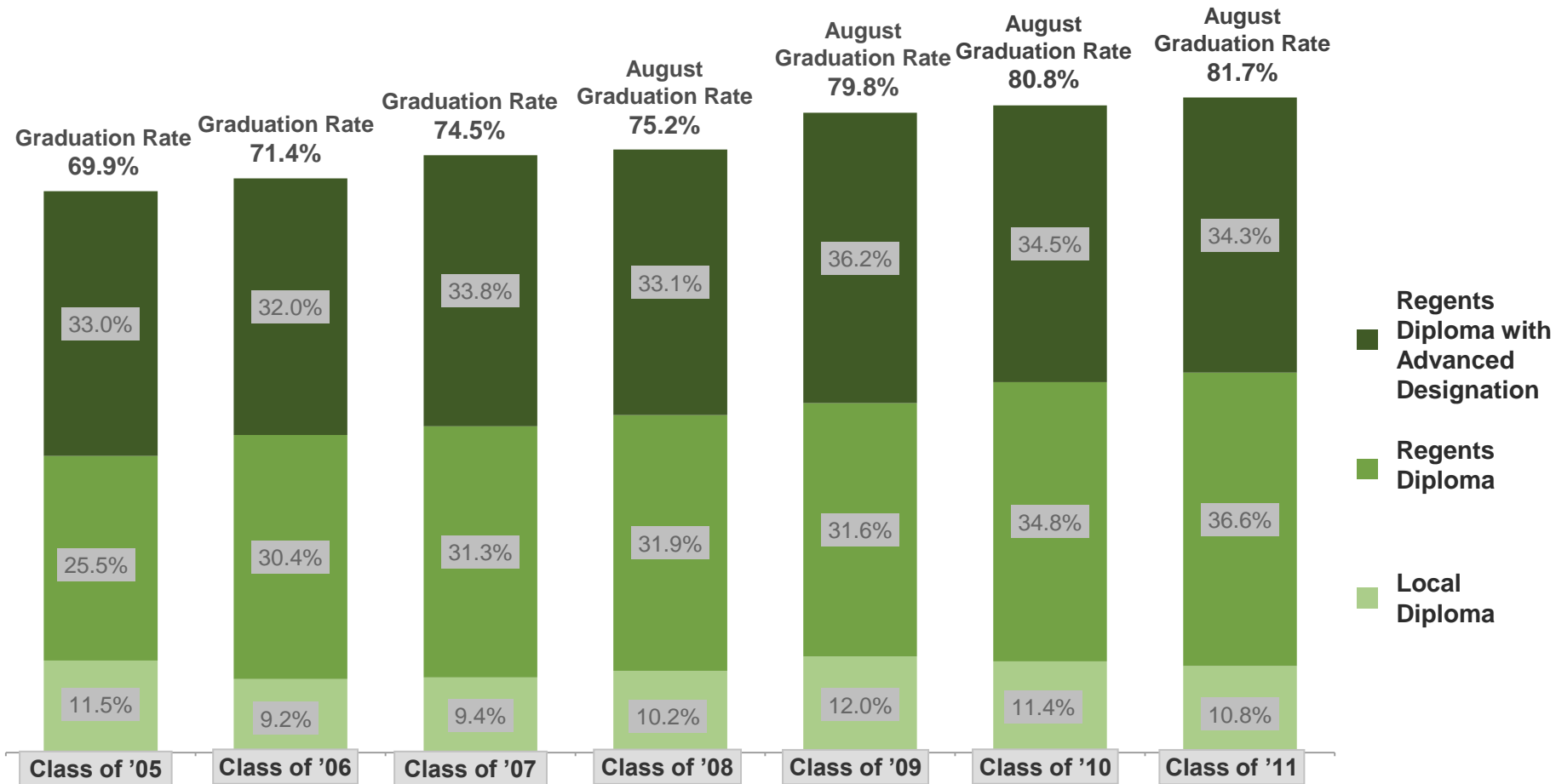
CITYWIDE MORE STUDENTS ARE EARNING REGENTS DIPLOMAS AFTER FOUR YEARS
