### **Superintendent's Report:**

- Superintendent Giunta thanked council members for working successfully on the rezoning project.
- Five finalists for the Big Apple Award
- Three more principals are being recognized as Distinguished Leaders
- Superintendent Giunta presented the Equity in Excellence Plan
  - O Pre-K through college continuum for graduation and college and career readiness
  - O Goals include an 80% on graduation rate by 2026 and \% of graduate college and career ready
  - O Eight initiatives that encompass the program are:
    - Universal Literacy (via reading coaches in all elementary schools, partnering with Teachers' College Reading and Writing Project and adoption of intervention programs such as Foundations and Great Leaps)
    - Algebra for All (by increasing time spent on math during the day, professional development, option for departmental organization in elementary schools, etc.)
    - AP for All (expanded AP offerings in 63 schools across the city; ensuring at least 5 AP courses available to every high school student).
    - Computer Science for All by 2025 (schools can choose how to implement the program; DOE is contracting with a variety of vendors; D26 is drafting a Technology Framework and a Vision for Technology for the district; 3 D26 schools are participating in a citywide pilot and all students are going to participate in the Hour of Code code.org. PD for technology will also be increased.
    - Middle School College Access for All (college campus visits for middle school students; D26 is encouraging field trips to local college campuses)
    - High School College Access for All (ex. Increased number of counselors in high schools)

- Single Shepherd (pairing students and counselors or social workers with a ratio of 1:100 in high needs districts. DC26 will continue to work towards creating a "Supportive Environment".
- District-Charter Partnerships not applicable in D26 because there are no charter schools in district.
- Lori Butera shared some of the family engagement programs that are running this summer (free parent workshops and classes) and fall - a D26 Family Night at Citi Field.
