The following resolution was presented to the public at the Community District Education Council 26 Calendar Meeting held on June 3, 2013 at MS 67, 51-60 Marathon Parkway, Room B44A, Little Neck, New York. A vote was taken and the resolution approved unanimously by voice/signature-vote of the CDEC members present, as reflected in the Minutes.

RESOLUTION # 1-2013 - CDEC 26 APPROVAL OF RE-ZONING PLAN FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL 172.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Community District Education Council 26 approve the following Re-Zoning Plan which is designed to provide clarity to Middle School 172 for students residing in Belle Park Manor Terrace area.

Middle School 172:

Whereas the addresses contained in the following area would be in the new I.S. 172 middle school zone:

- Begin at the southeast corner of Little Neck Parkway and Grand Central Parkway - - East on Grand Central Parkway, then - - South along the Nassau County Boundary , then - South on Hewlett Street, then - South along the Nassau County Boundary , then - West on Jamaica Avenue, then - North on Cross Isle Parkway, then - West on 88th Avenue, then - South on 242nd Street, then - West on 88th Avenue, then - North on 235 Court, then - West on 88th Avenue, then - South on Winchester Boulevard, then - West on Braddock Avenue, then - North on Springfield Boulevard, then - South on Grand Central Parkway, then - East on 215 Place, then - South on Whitehall Terrace, then - North on Grand Central Parkway, then - North on Hollis Hills Terrace, then - East on Richland Avenue, then - South on Peck Avenue, then - North on Bell Boulevard, then - East on 77th Avenue, then - South on Springfield Boulevard, then - East on Kingsbury Avenue, then - South on Grand Central Parkway, then - East on Union Turnpike, then - North on Little Neck Parkway to Grand Central Parkway (the point of origin).

Whereas the addresses contained in the following area would be in the new I.S. 109 middle school zone:

- Begin at southeast corner of Grand Central Parkway and Whitehall Terrace, then - East on Whitehall Terrace, then - North on 215 Place, then - East on Grand Central Parkway, then - South on Springfield Boulevard, then - East on Braddock Avenue, then - North on Winchester Boulevard, then - East on 88th Avenue, then - South on 235 Court, then - East on 88th Avenue, then - North on 242nd Street, then - East on 88th Avenue, then - South on Cross Isle Parkway, then - East on Jamaica Avenue, then - South on 225th Street, then - South on Cross Isle Parkway, then - West on 111th Avenue, then - North on 225th Street, then - West on 110th Avenue , then - South on 223rd Street, then - West and both sides of the street on 111th Avenue, then - South and both sides of the street on 223rd Street, then - West and both sides of the street on 112th Avenue, then - North on Springfield Boulevard, then - West on 110th Road, then - South on 216th Street, then - West on 111th Avenue, then - South on Witthoff Street, including both sides of the street between 213th and 214th Streets, then - North on 212th Street, including both sides of the street between Hollis Avenue and 104th Avenue, then

- West on 104th Avenue, then - North on 211th Place, then - West on 99th Avenue, then - North on 199th Street, then - East on Hillside Avenue, then - North on 202nd Street, then - South on Roothill Avenue, then, - North on 197th Street, then - North on Dunton Avenue, then - North on Dunton Street, then - East on Keno Avenue, then - North on Marengo Street, then - East on Grand Central Parkway to Whitehall Terrace (the point of origin).

NOTE: ALL ZONE LINES TO BE DRAWN ALONG THE CENTER OF VEHICULAR OR TRANSPORTATION RIGHTS OF WAY, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED OTHERWISE.
EXPLANATION: The re-zoning plan was presented to the community at a public hearing on the evening of April 25, 2013 at Middle School 67, Little Neck, NY. Community feedback was taken at that meeting as well as being accepted at CDEC Calendar Meeting of May 28 2013. The approved re-zoning plan will be submitted to the Department of Education, Office of Portfolio Planning for final review and implementation.
