Will do a PowerPoint presentation describing how the recent airspace redesign programs at LaGuardia Airport have created unprecedented noise and pollution problems in District 26 and some of the steps we can take moving forward, including support of the Part 150 Noise Study. Currently there is a bill on the Governor's desk that, if signed, will help alleviate this problem by mandating noise insulation for schools. The bill, A.7697/S.3841 or "Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study", was recommended by the NYCDEP in 2010. The DEP report also stressed the correlation between schoolchildren's increased failure rates and aircraft noise. The bill passed through the state senate and assembly almost unanimously.
